PROJECT TITLE AND DESCRIPTION

The Study about social and technological networks in Primary Healthcare

The study aims to verify if the digital systems impact or not the social and technological networks developed in primary healthcare. The methodological framework bases on a comprehensive model that encompasses qualitative and quantitative techniques of data. The analyze of data will be done with the theoretical support of the Actor Network Theory of Bruno Latour as well as with the Logic of Justification of Boltanski and Thèvenot. We expect that the results highlight what are the possibilities, difficulties, threats and opportunities of the digital systems in primary healthcare.
