PROJECT TITLE AND SHORT DESCRIPTION

Early modern censorship in action: making and using the Portuguese Index

This action requires a candidate interested in Early modern censorship studies (16th-18th centuries) with knowledge in the Iberian history of books and ideas; linguistic competences, in particular Latin and Portuguese, are required.

The field to investigate is the expurgative censorship in a double perspective: 1-toward a full history of the making of the 17th century Portuguese expurgatory; 2-about the efficiency of expurgation through the individual book analysis.

During this 24-month action (MSCA-IF), the expert researcher (ER) is expected:

1-to investigate about the main phases of the launching of the *Index Auctorum Damnatae Memoriae* (Lisbon, 1624): on one hand, the ER will have to find out how the censors elaborated every entry of the work, which will require investigations into archival and printed sources; on the other hand, the ER will study the production and reception of the Index along its period of availability until the second half of the 18th century;

2-to analyse methodologically the enforcement of the Iberian expurgatories throughout the books with regard to the fields of religion and law in the local libraries.

The scientific in charge will provide an initial training in the specific methodology of microcensorship analysis. The success of this action relies on high interest in material bibliography and strong willingness from the candidate to adapt to a genuine and new methodological field.
