PROJECT TITLE AND SHORT DESCRIPTION

Gender-inclusive language and text quality

(short title: GEqual)

There is a lack of linguistic research on language inclusive language in the Portuguese scientific linguist community (relevant exceptions are Matos 2020; Coutinho, 2021). This means that the social issue remains not supported enough (besides the handbooks and guidelines that have been produced, often without the involvement of the linguistic community). This project aims at contributing to filling this gap - developing research in line with the 5th Objective of Sustainable Development (Gender Equality).

An interactionist (or socio-interactionist) conception of language, in line with Saussure (2006), Coseriu (1987), and Volochinov (1977) points of view, is assumed. Besides, contrastive approaches are favored, which may highlight different possibilities, or different solutions, that languages find or allow. Finally, it is important to highlight the importance given to concrete activities of text production and (professional) revision. This means placing the problem under analysis in a broader context than the one in which it is usually considered - i.e. within the framework of textual quality.

From this point of view, the following objectives are stated:

- develop, through solid linguistic argumentation, the sustainability of gender-inclusive language in contexts of production and (professional) revision of texts;
- review, in articulation with the assumptions of the socio-interactionist conception of language and according to gender-inclusive language principles, some specific traditional notions within the scope of linguistic studies (referential and lexical cohesion, redundancy and progression, formulation and reformulation, textual quality);
- contribute to the implementation of gender-inclusive language strategies by making available online facilitating resources, which can quickly offer support and solutions to users in a real situation of production or revision of texts.
