

Sustainable development is development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.










The Decade of Action will:

Verified Campaign

- Fight "Infodemic" on misinformation
- Aims to share factbased information based on science
- Content prepared in 10 languages reaching more than 400 million people
