

PUBLIC NOTICE N.º 316/2023

Job opening for 1 faculty position of Assistant Professor in the area of History of Art of the School of Social Sciences and Humanities – NOVA University Lisbon

In accordance with what is determined by article 39 of the University Teacher Career Statute (ECDU), approved by the Decree-law 448/79, 13 November, in its present writing, the Dean of NOVA FCSH – Universidade NOVA de Lisboa, Professor Luís Baptista, by delegation of powers, in the terms specified in number 1.2 of the Dispatch 7597/2021, 23 July, published in *Diário da República*, 2nd series, number 148, August 2, hereby announces the international and documental job opening for one faculty position of Assistant Professor in the area of History of Art, with a relevant CV in the fields of History of Architecture and Urbanism in the Early Modern Period, and of Heritage.

Applications are accepted for a period of 30 business days counting from the day after this announcement is published in *Diário da República*.

This job opening as well as the Committee nomination were authorized by order of Professor João Sàágua, Rector of Universidade NOVA de Lisboa, on 13th February of 2023.

This is an international application procedure and follows the guidelines stated in article 37 and following of the University Teacher Career Statute (ECDU) and in NOVA's University Regulation for University Teacher Career Applications, Dispatch 3012/2015, February 20, published in *Diário da República*, 2nd series, number 58, March 24.

I — Admission requirements:

- 1 According to article 41-A of ECDU candidates must hold a PhD degree.
- 2 Candidates must hold a PhD degree in the area of History of Art or in a related area.
- 3 Candidates must master spoken and written Portuguese and English.

II – Submission of applications:

1 – Applications must be sent to the following email address: <u>concursosdocentes@fcsh.unl.pt</u>. The email title must contain the reference of this notice.

2 – Applications are formalized, under penalty of exclusion, with the supporting documents listed below. All the required documents must be submitted in PDF format. Short names for files are recommended. Links are not accepted as substitutes for these documents.



- a) Documents proving the fulfilment of the legal requirements demanded in no. 1 and 2, point I;
- b) Sworn statement declaring the mastering of Portuguese and English at a teaching level;
- c) Application form available at <u>https://www.fcsh.unl.pt/static/documentos/concursos/docentes/formularios/FORMULARIO_PROF</u> AUXILIAR.docx;
- Curriculum Vitae of the candidate, indicating published works as well as performed activities regarding all the functions and responsibilities of the Professors, mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of ECDU. The curriculum should be organized according to point III of this Public Notice;
- e) Copies of five of the written works mentioned in the *curriculum vitae*, considering their contribution to the development of the disciplinary area of this call;
- f) Two syllabi (including class planning, grading criteria and bibliography) for two courses within the disciplinary area of this call; one of these must be for a course on Introduction to Heritage Studies; other teaching materials deemed pertinent by the candidate for the area of this call;
- g) Research and Teaching Development Project that the candidate means to adopt in the future showing the candidate's contribution to NOVA FCSH.

3 – All communications and notifications with the candidate during this procedure will be made by email. For this purpose, the candidate must indicate the email address in the application form and sign the attending authorization.

4 – All applications must include a list of the supporting documents.

5 – The supporting documents attesting the fulfillment of the requirements for recruitment in public functions can be replaced by a statement included in the above-mentioned application form.

6 – Applications duly instructed with the above-mentioned documents must be submitted within 30 business days, counting from the day immediately after the publication of this Notice in *Diário da República*.

7 – The supporting documents of the application must be written in Portuguese or in English.

III — Evaluation criteria:

The criteria, indicators and ponderations for the evaluation and ranking of the candidates are as follows:

- 1 Scientific component of each candidate's curriculum vitae (50%):
- 1.1 Publication of books (including exhibition catalogues), book chapters, and journal articles; peerreviewed publications will be valued as will the internationalization of the scientific production within the domains of History of Architecture and Urbanism in the Early Modern Period, and Built Heritage Management and Conservation (0-20)



1.2 – Coordination and/or participation in research projects evaluated by competent entities, national or international, with relevant impact in the domains of History of Architecture and Urbanism in the Early Modern Period, and Built Heritage Management and Conservation (0-7);

1.3 – Papers presented at scientific meetings in the domains of History of Architecture and Urbanism in the Early Modern Period, and Built Heritage Management and Conservation (0-3).

1.4. – Professional experience in the exercise of functions concerning the study, classification, management and/or conservation of Built Heritage (0-18);

1.5. – Other significant activities (such as membership of scientific boards, research centres, editorial boards, advanced, postgraduate and complementary training, research conducted beyond academia, among others) (0-2).

2 – Teaching Component (30 %):

2.1 – Teaching experience within the domains of History of Architecture and Urbanism in the Early Modern Period, and Built Heritage Management and Conservation (0 - 10);

2.2 – Supervision and co-supervision of thesis (2nd and 3rd cycles) and of other non-curricular components of the 2nd cycle (Traineeship Reports and Project Work) (0-8);

2.3 – Teaching materials submitted to this call (0-12).

3 – Research and Teaching Development Project (15%)

3.1 – Contribution for the institution's mission regarding the development of teaching, including its international dimension (0 - 5);

3.2 – Contribution for the institution's mission regarding the development of research, including its international dimension (0-5);

3.3 – Contribution for the institution's mission regarding the recruitment of competitive funding (0-3);

- 3.4 Other relevant contributions (0-2).
- 4 Other relevant activities (5%):
- 4.1 Participation in activities of academic extension and knowledge transfer to society (0-3);

4.2. - Participation in academic management bodies and activities (0-2)

V - Selection Process:

1 – After the deadline for applications the Committee meets for assessing and ranking the candidates.

2 — Based on the *curricula* assessment, their suitability to the scientific area of this call, the supporting documents, and their evaluation according to the above-mentioned criteria, the Committee admits the candidates with a final classification of 50 or more, and excludes those with a final classification of less than 50.

3— The candidates who are not admitted will be notified in the terms of the Code of Administrative Procedure.

4 — The Committee publicizes the list of the admitted candidates considering the order of their evaluation as well as a written statement.

5 — The order of the final list of the admitted candidates is determined by the Committee votes, according to the list formerly mentioned, and in accordance with no. 11 a) to f) of article 16 of NOVA University Regulation for University Teacher Career Applications.

VI – The admitted and excluded candidates are notified by e-mail according to no. 1 c) and no. 2 b) of article 112 of the Code of Administrative Procedure.



VII – The process of this procedure can be consulted by the candidates on request. The request must be sent to the Division of Human Resources by an email addressed to the President of the Committee: concursosdocentes@fcsh.unl.pt.

VIII – If the Pd.D. degree of the winner candidate has been obtained from a foreign university, its recognition must obey the Decree-Law 66/2018, August 16. The candidates must undertake all formal obligations described in this diploma until the day of the signature of the contract, under penalty of exclusion.
