Competition for Full Professor in the scientific area of the 3rd Group – General Legal Sciences (all disciplinary areas of this group stated in no. 5.3 of the Order no. 6444/2015 of 9th June, excluding Economic Studies [subparagraph e]), for NOVA Law School of the New University of Lisbon.

António Manuel Bensabat Rendas, Rector of New University of Lisbon, declares open this international competition for a period of 30 working days from the day this notice is published in "*Diário da República*", for the position of 1 (one) Full Professor in the scientific area of the 3rd Group – General Legal Sciences (all disciplinary areas of this group stated in no. 5.3 of the Order no. 6444/2015 of 9th June, excluding Economic Studies [subparagraph e]), for NOVA Law School. This is an international application procedure and follows the guidelines stated in article 37 et seq. of the University Teacher Career Statutes (ECDU) approved by Decree-Law 448/79 of 13th November with the new amendment introduced by Decree-Law 205/2009, 31st of August, amended by Law 8/2010 of the 13th May and the UNL University Teacher Career Application Regulations, number 3012/2015, published in "*Diário da República*" no. 58, series II, 24th of March.

Subject: Contest for Full Professor in the area of the 3rd Group – General Legal Sciences (all disciplinary areas of this group stated in no. 5.3 of the Order no. 6444/2015 of 9th June, excluding Economic Studies [subparagraph e]), for NOVA Law School of the New University of Lisbon.

I. Admission Requirements: Regarding the above mentioned statutes, this application procedure has the following requirements, in accordance with article 40 of ECDU:

- a) Hold a doctorate degree (Ph.D) for more than five years;
- b) Aggregation exams certificate (provas agregação);

Candidates must have a doctoral degree (Ph.D) in Law and, cumulatively, general legal sciences scientific production.

II. Submission of Applications: Candidates must submit their applications, either in digital format (PEN) or hard copy. The application can be handed in at the Rectory of New University of Lisbon, Academic Services, located at *Campus de Campolide, 1099-085 Lisboa*, or be sent by post, with a written application form, available at the Rectory's Academic Division or on-line at: <http://www.unl.pt/en/nova/faculty>.

1. The application process must include the following documentation:
 - a) Ph.D degree certificate obtained for more than five years in the scientific area of the contest;
 - b) Aggregation exams certificate;
 - c) 9 copies of the Candidate's Curriculum Vitae, in digital format (Pen Drives USB) or hard copies;
 - d) 9 copies, in digital format (Pen Drives USB) or hard copies, of each work published and mentioned in the Curriculum Vitae, preferably in digital format, including the most representative with regard to his/her contribution to the development and evolution of the scientific area for which the present call is open;
 - e) Scientific and educational development project (less than 5000 words) that the applicant proposes to adopt in the future, which will be evaluated in the scientific performance and pedagogical capacity criteria.

2. The documents proving that the candidate meets the general mandatory requirements for recruitment in public functions can be replaced by a statement in the application form, referred in section II (submission of applications), available at the Academic Division of the Rectory and online at <http://www.unl.pt/en/nova/faculty>.
3. The candidates should present within the period mentioned in the preamble of this public notice, the form and the required documentation.
4. The lack of any documentary evidence will determine the rejection of the application.
5. Candidates must organize their curriculum vitae according to the systematics of section III of this notice.

III. Evaluation criteria: The criteria and weightings for the evaluation of admitted candidates approved by the committee are:

1. Scientific Performance, development and innovation - 45%:

- 1.1. Publication of scientific articles and books;
- 1.2. Coordination and participation in research projects;
- 1.3. Management and coordination of research units;
- 1.4. Presentations at scientific conferences and colloquiums;
- 1.5. Member of scientific magazines and scientific awards boards;
- 1.6. Take part in scientific commissions, organizations or networks;
- 1.7. Awards and distinctions.

2. Pedagogical Capacity - 45%

- 2.1. Coordination and teaching of curricular units, taking into account the diversity (subjects and cycles of studies), the pedagogical practice and the number of students;
- 2.2. The publication of lessons and other pedagogical material;
- 2.3. Supervision of doctoral thesis;
- 2.4. Active participation on academic examinations committees and competitions for teaching and research careers;
- 2.5. Awards and distinctions.

3. Other relevant activities - 10%

- 3.1 Community service provision, patenting and spin-offs creation, scientific outreach and training activities.
- 3.2 Positions held in University bodies and Organic Units, coordination of departments, sections and courses or other positions and temporary tasks.

4. In the application's evaluation it will be given special emphasis to the works and activities carried out in the area of the contest, in the five years prior to the date of this public notice.

5. The national and international recognition of the candidate's activities will always be taken into account.

V - Selection Process

1. Finishing the applications' deadline, the committee meets for assessing and ranking the candidates.
2. After the answers of the excluded candidates and respective decision, or the admission of all candidates, the Committee will evaluate and order the candidates according to the criteria mentioned in III. The Committee will admit the candidates with final grade, in absolute merit equal or greater than 50, or will exclude them, when they have a final grade below 50.
3. Each committee member will issue a written document with the final ordering of the admitted applicants.
4. In case of exclusion, the candidate will be notified of the preliminary hearing, according to article 121 et seq. of the Administrative Procedure Code.
5. The ranking order of the selected applicants is made by vote of the committee members, respecting the order presented in the preceding paragraph III and in accordance with article 16, number 11, subparagraphs a) to f) of the University Teacher Career Application Regulations.

VI – Regarding subparagraph h) of the article 9 of the Portuguese Constitution, the Portuguese Public Administration, as an employer, actively promotes a policy of equal opportunities among men and women in the access to employment and career development, and takes scrupulous measures to avoid every form of discrimination.
