CROSS-UNIVERSITY MOBILITY PROGRAMME FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

- **Duration:**
1 to 5 months
- **Beneficiaries:**
PhD students & early-researchers
(within 8 years post-PhD)
- **Total:**
25 mobility months until the end of 2027
- **Funding:**
Subsistence costs of **2500€**
per month (including accommodation
and living expenses) + travel expenses
up to 500€ per mobility.
- **Programme call closure:**
September 2027
There may be more than one call
depending on unallocated mobility
months.

INTERDISCIPLINARY MOBILITY PROGRAMME

- **Duration:**
3 to 4 days
- **Beneficiaries:**
Academic staff
(Teaching/Administrative staff)
& Researchers
- **Total:**
At least **10** mobilities
until **30 June 2027**
- **Funding:**
1200€ (for accommodation,
travel and living expenses)
- **Programme call closure:**
31 May 2027
Continuous submissions
on a first-come, first-served
basis, until all allocated funds
have been exhausted

MENTORSHIP MOBILITY PROGRAMME

- **Duration:**
1 month (can be divided into 2x15 days)
- **Beneficiaries:**
Research Managers who have
participated in the EUTOPIA_HEALTH
Training Programme for Research
Managers: Advancing institutional
excellence*
- **Total:**
6 mobilities to be accomplished
until the end of **July 2028**
(1 mobility granted by call phase)
- **Funding:**
4000€ (for accommodation,
travel and living expenses).
- **Timeline:**
2x/year (2025, 2026 and 2027)
- **Programme call closure:**
September 2027

Note:
Except for the Mentorship Mobility Programme, mobilities can be used to attend the following trainings:

- Bioinformatics / Advanced computational skills in OMICs to design targeted prevention and treatment
- Ethical and professionalism aspects of dealing with health-related dataset.
- Advanced technical skills to develop high-tech solutions for mental health.
